



NORTH DELTA BASEBALL ASSOCIATION UMPIRE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM CLINIC DATES 2012

NDBA UDP has confirmed its Level 1 and 2 Clinic Dates for 2012. In that regard, the NDBA UDP continues to be part of the British Columbia Baseball Umpires Association (BCBUA). We are however offering a different clinic structure than last year for Level 1 and 2, as we continue our interlocking with Newton we will be offering not only a combined clinic with Newton but also a single-weekend day clinic for each Level. So whether you are a new umpire or a returning umpire, you **must** register and take one of the below clinics. NDBA UDP's Level 1 Clinic Date this year will be Sunday 19 February & the Level 2 Clinic Date this year will be Sunday 26 February.

Level 1 Clinic \$25.00; FREE for **See Below**

- New umpire or born in 2000 (11; As Of 2011-DEC-31) or earlier; Mandatory for umpiring Mosquito and below

Level 2 Clinic \$50.00; FREE for **See Below**

- Level 1 for 2 years or born in 1998 (13; As Of 2011-DEC-31) or earlier; Mandatory for umpiring PeeWee and above; Ability to umpire outside the area of North Delta and eligible for provincials after being Level 2 for 2 years and completing the requirement of a take home exam and passing annually

Returning umpires that attend our clinic in full & umpire at least 5 games in North Delta during the season are free, they must supply a cheque payable to NDBA post dated for 2012-SEP-01 covering their clinic cost, Level 1 \$25.00, Level 2 \$50.00, however the cheque will not be cashed as long as the previous requirements are met

New umpires that attend our clinic in full & umpire at least 5 games in North Delta during the season must pay their clinic cost, they must supply a cheque payable to NDBA covering their clinic cost, Level 1 \$25.00, Level 2 \$50.00, however will be eligible the next season to have their clinic cost paid the same as any returning umpire as long as the previous requirements are met

Returning umpires or New umpires that attend another areas clinic in full & umpire at least 5 games in North Delta during the season must pay their clinic cost, they must supply a cheque covering their clinic cost, Level 1 \$25.00, Level 2 \$50.00, however will be eligible the next season to have their clinic cost paid the same as any returning umpire as long as the previous requirements are met

The NDBA UDP Level 1 and 2 clinics will be held at Mary Jane Shannon Elementary located at 10682 144 St in Surrey. The Level 1 clinic date is Sunday 19 February 2012, running from (08:45)09:00-16:00, in both the Classroom and the Gym. The Level 2 clinic date is Sunday 26 February 2012, running from (08:45)09:00-17:00, in both the Classroom and the Gym. Registrants are encouraged to show up early, 15 minutes, since late registrants will not be allowed and registrants must attend the entire clinic. Registrants should also wear their Umpire Dress Code (see *Dress Code 2012* distribution for more information) and bring a BiFold for Notes along with a Pencil/Pen.
